



GENERAL INFORMATION

The World Scout Parliamentary Union (WSPU) Kenya welcomes you to Kenya for the historic first WSPU General Assembly to be held in Africa (11th WSPU GA 2025). The Assembly will be held in Nairobi and Nyeri Counties from 6th to 13th November 2025. Nyeri County hosts PAXTU, the second home of the founder of Scouting Lord Baden Powell and his resting place. The 11th WSPU General Assembly is organized by WSPU Kenya which will be the decision-making body of the Assembly.

I. Venues

The venue of the youth Assembly is Nyeri County, Kenya, the second home of Lord Baden Powell 'PAXTU' the founder of Scouting Movement. The main Assembly will be held in Nairobi County, The Capital City of Kenya and the only capital City to have a national park in its midst.

II. Dates

The dates for the 11th WSPU General Assembly and the Youth Assembly are from 6th to 13th November, 2025.

III. Conference language

The 11th WSPU GA 2025 Assembly language will be English, French and Sign language.

IV. Eligibility of Participants

a. Delegates

The delegates should be Parliamentarians who are members of the National Assemblies, Senate and Members of Regional/ County Assemblies.

b. Youth Leaders

Each Country that is participating is highly encouraged to bring two (2) youth representatives (Male and Female) aged between 18 -35 years. This is in accordance to the 7th WSPU General Assembly when the importance of young leaders was emphasized.

c. Observers

Observers are representatives from NSPA's as well as other representatives such as staff of NSPA or National Scout Organization (NSO) or like-minded Organizations invited by WSPU Kenya.



d. **Accompanying persons**

Delegates, young leaders and observers may bring accompanying persons such as their assistants, spouses or children.

e. **Exhibitors**

Exhibitors will have a special place to showcase their Countries, NSPA, NSO's or organizations in regard to youth empowerment programmes. Each booth will have a space for 2 people.

V. Registration fees are set as indicated below

- a. Invited delegates – USD 400
- b. Youth – USD 200
- c. Observers – USD 300
- d. Accompanying persons USD 100
- e. Exhibitors – USD 300 (2 pax per booth)

VI. Registration fee Payment

- a. All registration category fees cover the Assembly and the programmes, it does **not** cover accommodation and transport to and from the Country of origin.
- b. The fees must be bank transferred before the Assembly unless otherwise agreed with the assembly secretariat.

The World Scout Parliamentary Union (WSPU) is an independent Association of Parliamentarians, functioning according to Fundamental Scout Principles expressed in the Constitution of the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM). World Scout Parliamentary Union (WSPU) which exists in 106 countries.

The aim of the WSPU is to establish an international network of parliamentarians to support, at their level, the various aspects of WOSM activities, whether nationally or internationally.

The establishment of the World Scout Parliamentary Union (WSPU) was as a result of a meeting held in 1990, March 25-29, in Seoul, Korea where Nine Parliamentarians from six countries (Korea, England, Japan, Kenya, Costa Rica, Philippines) participated met to actualize the decision of the meeting held in Cairo, Egypt, October, 1989, where the Idea of WSPU was born.

The World Scout Parliamentary Union (WSPU) Kenya Caucus was formed pursuant to Standing Order 259A of the Kenya National Assembly Standing Orders on 26th February 2014. WSPU Programmes in Kenya are executed through an intergovernmental structure approved by the Cabinet on 12th May 2022.
